3	SECTION 1. REGULATION OF HYDRAULIC FRACTURING.
4	Section 1421(d)(1) of the Safe Drinking Water Act
5	(42 U.S.C. 300h(d)(1)) is amended by striking subpara-
6	graph (B) and inserting:
7	"(B) includes the underground injection of
8	fluids or propping agents pursuant to hydraulic
9	fracturing operations related to oil, gas, or geo-

thermal production activities; but

1	"(C) excludes the underground injection of
2	natural gas for purposes of storage.".
